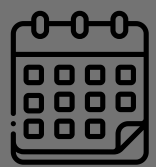

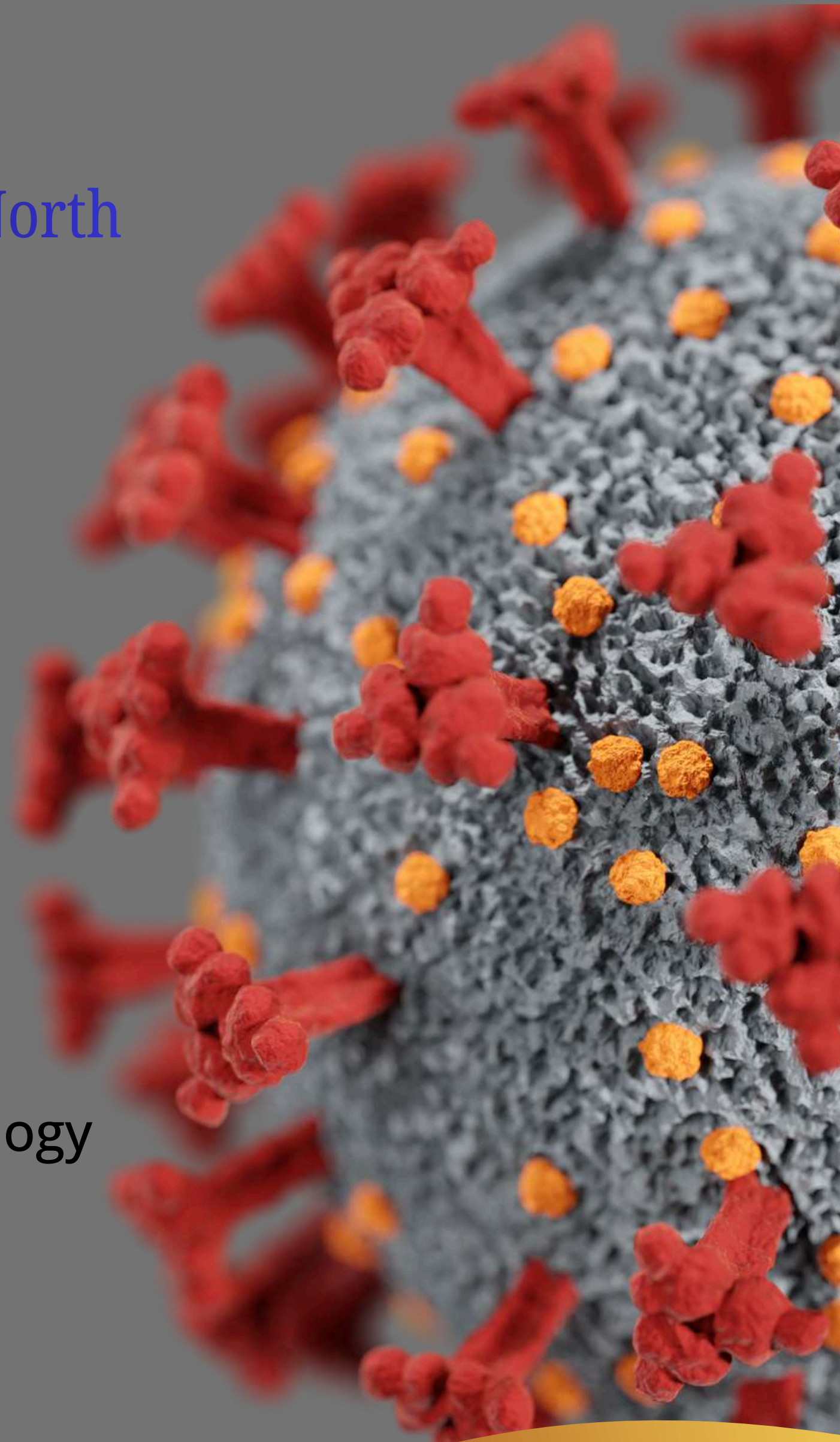



ATTRACTIONS OF ROME, ITALY



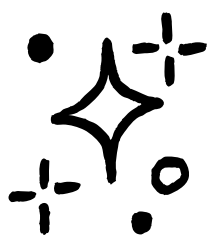
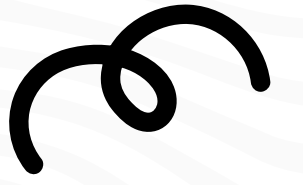
